Paper Pile-Ups and Cumbersome Credentialing

Challenge

The team at the rural hospital realized they had a problem when they were hiring providers faster than they could credential them. Their manual, paper-based credentialing process was time-consuming, inefficient, and unable to handle the increasing number of providers, which meant they were missing out on potential revenue.

“ We had spreadsheets with provider names and information, but then we had their paper files in cabinets with some files being over 100 pages. Gathering the information and knowing who was due was a time-consuming task in and of itself.”



The multiple-paper filing system slowed down the credentialing process making it difficult for the staff to keep up with the volume of work and causing delays that had a ripple effect on the entire organization. The physical clutter also caused issues by making it difficult to move around the office and making it easy to misplace documents.

“I was lucky to get maybe one or two providers done because I was printing all those papers out and separating them into folders. We were also delayed in general because you don't have time to go through a spreadsheet and see what's coming up.”

Solution
